School Readiness Assessment (and early detection of Dyslexia)

Our diagnostic team conducts a comprehensive school readiness assessment for children aged 3 to 6 years 11 months. Our Psychologists are trained to use a number of assessments, including the Cognitive Profiling System; a computer based program used in the early detection of Dyslexia.

The assessment process below may vary depending on the needs of each client:

- IV. A parent/caregiver questionnaire assessing child development using the Developmental Profile, 3rd Edition (DP-3).
- IV. Formal School Readiness assessment using the Bracken Basic Concept Scale: Expressive (BBCS:E) and screening for Dyslexia using the Cognitive Profiling System (Approximately 2 hours).
- IV. A comprehensive parent/teacher report within one week of the final assessment.
- IV. An *optional** feedback session with parents/caregivers to discuss recommendations for intervention and follow-up. (Approximately 30 minutes).
